Gaza, Palestine: Situation Overview

Since October 07, the escalation of conflict and significant displacement throughout Gaza have left over **2.2 million** Palestinian civilians into a dire humanitarian crisis. A total blockade has rendered more than one million people homeless, forcing them to live in temporary shelters. With no access to life-saving relief supplies, medical aid, and basic necessities, the situation has turned into a catastrophe, particularly affecting women, children, the sick, and the injured.

Ongoing attacks on hospitals have also impacted women's health, with tens of thousands of pregnant women and newborn babies' lives are in danger. UNFPA estimates there are currently **50,000+ pregnant women** in Gaza – of whom 5,500 expected to deliver in the next month – who are unable to obtain basic health services.

Alkhidmat Collaborative Response

Since the complete siege after October 07, Gaza has been subjected to a strict land and sea blockade, which strictly prevents humanitarian agencies and relief supplies from reaching the displaced people of Palestine and families living in temporary shelters. The crisis escalated when the only Egypt-Gaza Rafah crossing was bombed by Israel, leading to the strict blockage of relief aid to Gaza.

Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan, in collaboration with international partners, is delivering life-saving relief supplies in Gaza, including, hot meals, food packs, shelter and medical aid to displaced individuals and families living in temporary shelters and camps. Our relief supplies are reaching displaced Palestinian families, children, and women on a daily basis.

Once the humanitarian corridor is established, our trained Disaster Management Teams and doctors, along with relief assistance, are fully prepared to go to Gaza.

Gaza Press Briefing

Alkhidmat dispatched the first consignment of 13 truckloads of relief aid to Gaza.

In a significant humanitarian effort, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan, has dispatched its inaugural consignment of essential relief supplies to Gaza, including foodgrains, medicines, delivery kits, baby kits, hygiene kits, mosquito nets, and more. Secretary General Syed Waqas Jafri expressed the Alkhidmat's commitment to hand over these supplies to the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), which will integrate them into aid shipments from Pakistan to reach Gaza.

Alkhidmat has been actively engaged in relief operations in Gaza in collaboration with international charities since October 7, addressing the severe humanitarian crisis characterized by pressing needs for water, food, and medical aid. With already sending Rs. 150 million relief materials to Gaza and an additional Rs. 500 million allocated, Alkhidmat Foundation is dedicated to providing sustained support for Gaza's affected population, delivering relief supplies through international agencies to the Rafah border, and welcoming the collaboration of other NGOs in this critical mission.

How Alkhidmat Working with Partners

While advocating the urgent need for the opening of borders and humanitarian corridors, Alkhidmat is responding to the humanitarian crisis, in collaboration with our international partners, who already have their presence and offices established in Gaza.

Relief goods amounting to **Rs 100 million (357,453 USD)** have already been handed over to our partners in Gaza, and another **Rs. 400 million (1.42 million USD)** have been committed. Our international partners on the ground include Gazze Destek Dernegi, Onsur, Hayrat Yardim, IHH, Cansuyu and Bridges of Civilisations for Development-Palestine.
