

Torrential Rains & Flood Emergency – Punjab, Pakistan

Situation Report

Highlights/Overview:

A state of emergency has been declared in several districts across Punjab due to unprecedented monsoon rains and flash flooding, claiming 63 lives and injuring 290 people in the past 24 hours.
