SITUATION REPORT 11

28 August, 2025



HIGHLIGHTS

Monsoon rains have intensified across Pakistan, triggering GLOFs and flash floods in KP and GB, and urban and riverine flooding in Punjab, with over 805 fatalities reported. From 29 August to 2 September, widespread rain, wind, and thunderstorms with heavy to very heavy falls are forecast in Kashmir, Punjab/Islamabad, and KP, with isolated heavy showers in South Punjab, while GB is likely to receive rain from 30 August to 1 September. Sindh may see rainfall on 30-31 August, and Balochistan from 30 August to 1 September.

The Flood Forecasting Division has reported exceptionally high floods in the Ravi (Shahdara 217,660 cusecs) and Sutlej (Ganda Singh Wala 261,053 cusecs), and a very high flood in the Chenab at Qadirabad (534,409 cusecs, down from 660,020), with mixed levels at other points.

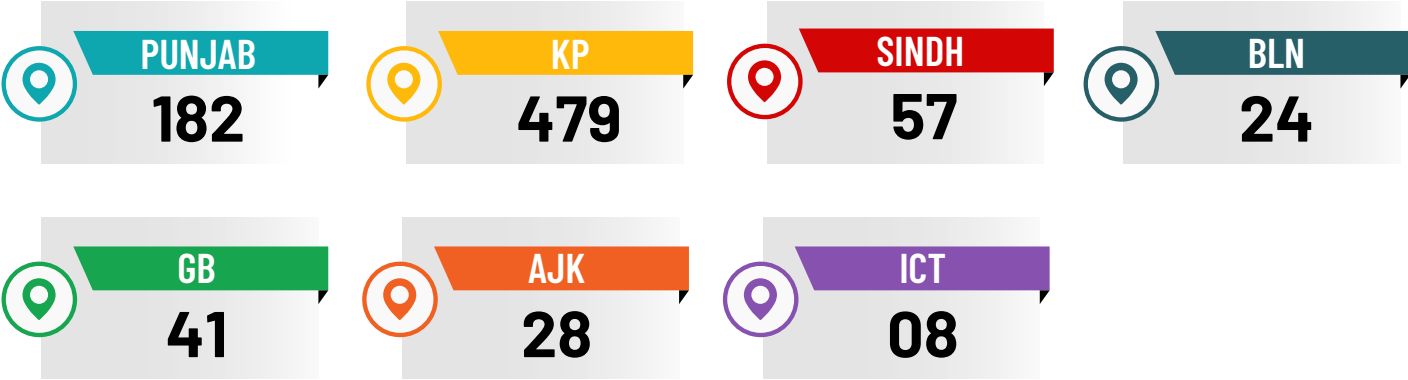

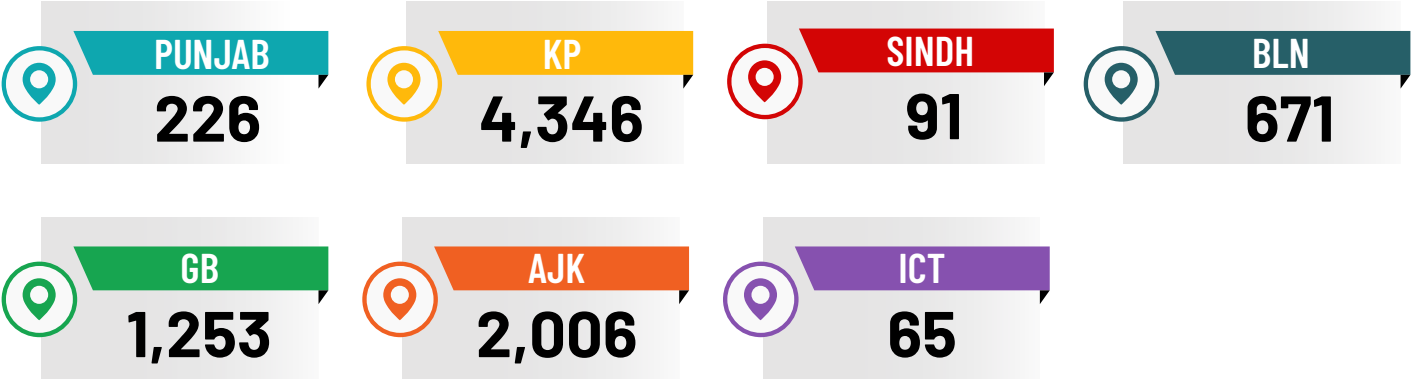

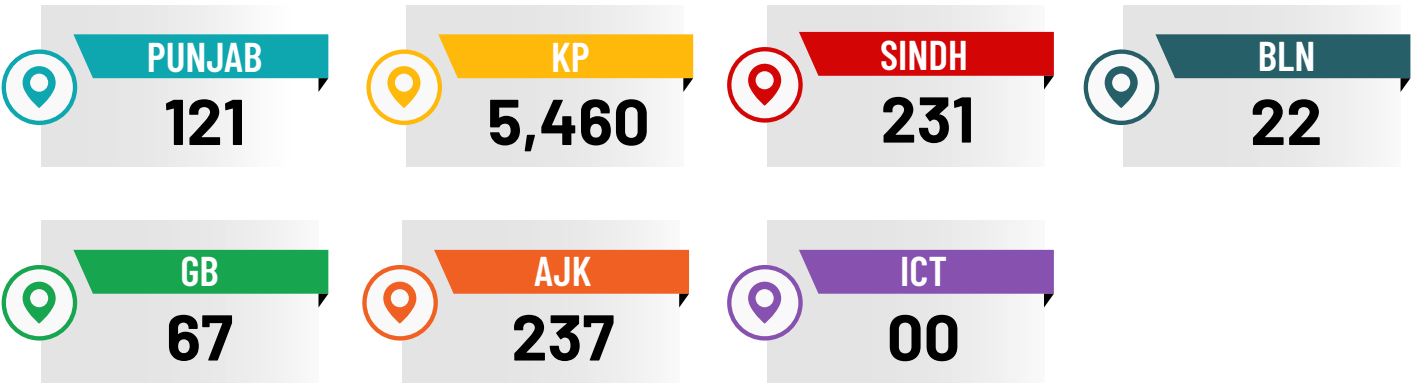
CUMULATIVE LOSS & DAMAGES

ESSENTIAL NEEDS

Flood-affected communities in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK), and Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) urgently require relief support. In Punjab, riverine floods have created immediate needs for food, clean water, hygiene and dignity kits, mosquito nets, tents, and NFIs.

In KPK, displaced families require hygiene kits, kitchen sets, folding beds, water tanks, and jerry cans. In GB, priority needs include food, hygiene kits, dignity kits, and safe drinking water. Timely provision of these items is essential to protect the health, dignity, and well-being of affected populations.

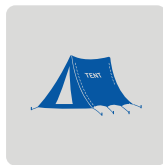
