HIGHLIGHTS

Over 800,000 people have been evacuated and nearly 2,000 villages affected across Punjab due to the ongoing monsoon rains, which have impacted almost 2 million people and forced the relocation of around 500,000 livestock. Nationwide, over 854 fatalities have been reported. In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan, glacial lake outburst floods (GLOFs) and flash floods have been observed, while Punjab continues to face severe urban and riverine flooding.

Between 01-03 September, there remains a heightened risk of urban flooding and flash floods in Narowal, Sialkot, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sheikhupura, and Hafizabad. Landslides are also expected in parts of KP, Murree, Galliyat, and Kashmir. Very high to exceptionally high flows in the Sutlej, Ravi, and Chenab rivers may further worsen flooding conditions in Lahore, Gujranwala, and Gujrat divisions. The public and travelers are strongly advised to avoid vulnerable areas and remain updated through official weather advisories.






CUMULATIVE LOSS & DAMAGES

ESSENTIAL NEEDS

Flood-affected communities across Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK), and Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) are in urgent need of humanitarian assistance. In Punjab, riverine flooding has left families requiring food supplies, clean drinking water, hygiene kits, dignity kits, mosquito nets, tents, and other NFIs.

In KPK, displaced households need hygiene kits, kitchen sets, folding beds, water tanks, and jerry cans to meet basic survival needs. In GB, priority requirements include food items, hygiene and dignity kits, and safe drinking water. Immediate relief support is critical to safeguard the health, dignity, and well-being of millions affected by the ongoing disaster.
