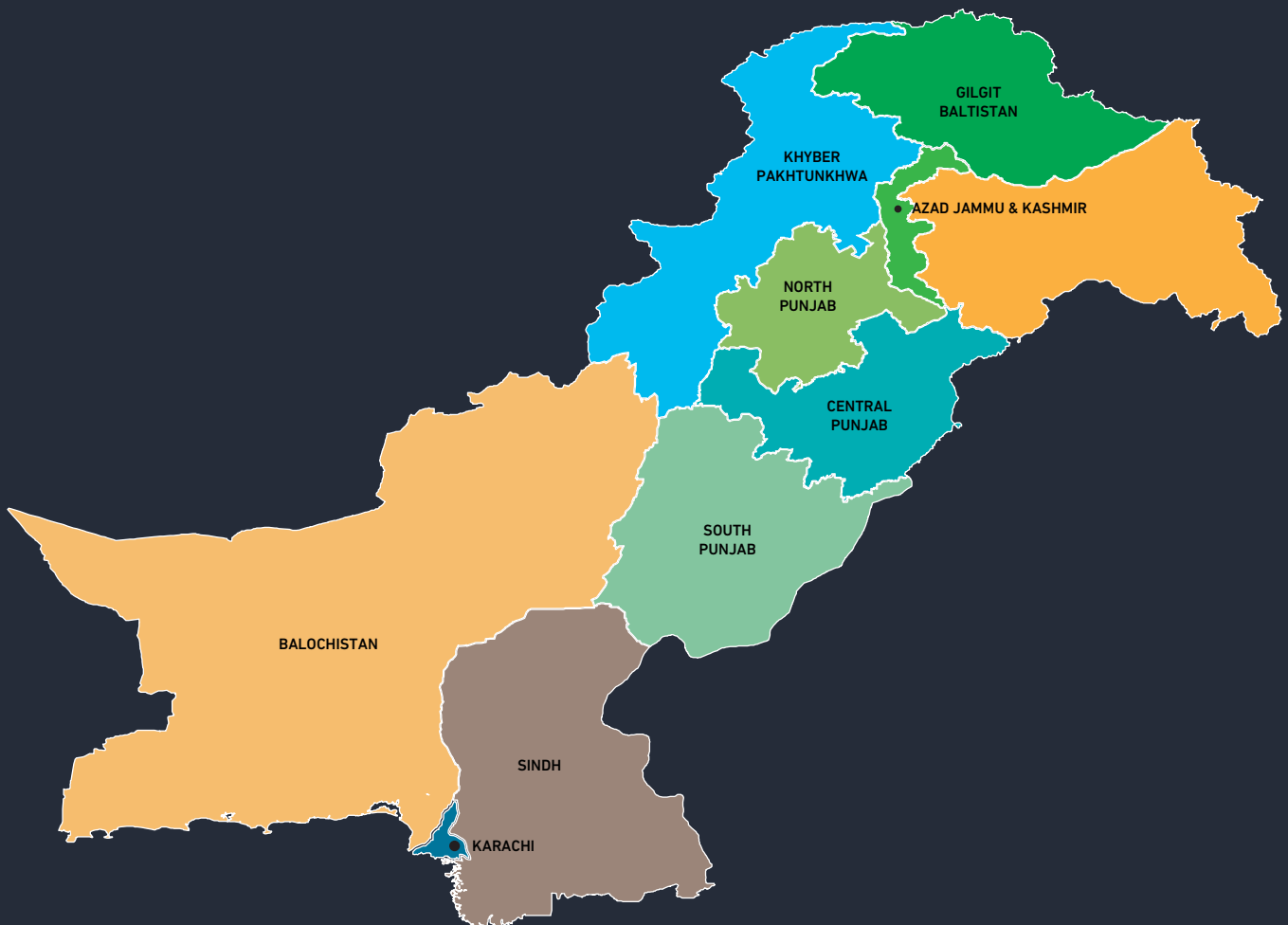

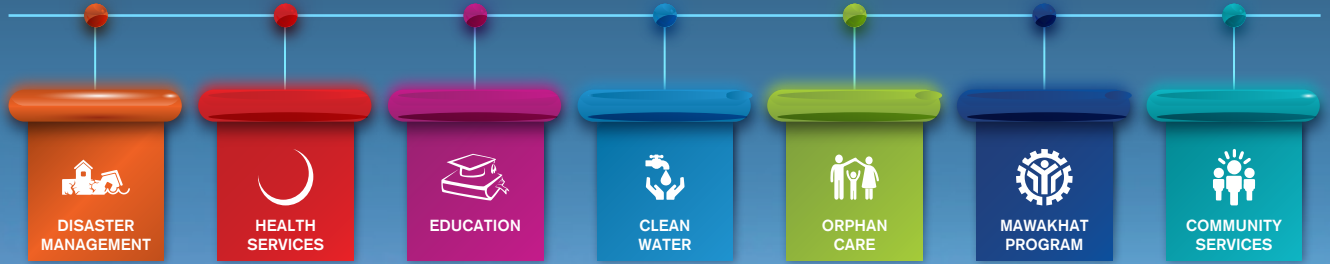

CORE VALUES





Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan has been established under “Societies Registration Act XX1, 1860” to undertake humanitarian aid work as non-profit organization in the fields of disaster management, health services, education, clean water, orphan care, interest-free loans and community services. In order to maintain transparency, a management body has been devised in the form of General Council (GC) and Central Board of Management (CBM). GC governs the organization, setting out its priorities and objectives, focusing on strategic planning and governance. It also evaluates performance and approves relevant new policies and procedures.

CBM guides the central, regional and local management to undertake necessary measurements to pursue the mission of the organization. Apart from effective implementation of the humanitarian welfare projects and preparation of their progress reports, CBM also builds capacity of partners and staff on the logical framework, data management, data analysis and result-oriented programs.

As part of the efforts to maintain an image of a well-reputed non-profit organization, AKFP follows a remuneration policy to attract and retain talented individuals. The remuneration principle is competitive to the market but not be market driven, and ensures that all of the operations of AKFP are cost effective and affordable, and in line with our philosophy of being cost effective.

WORKING WITH SYNERGY

We establish effective partnerships worldwide with local and international NGOs with a principal function to execute humanitarian projects in Pakistan with provision of services including medical, social and psychological services as well as integration activities, care and nursing, material and financial support, educational and information services and training. Cross-border relief activities are also executed in collaboration with our international partners devoted to work with the local communities. Our assistance is mainly aimed to help the orphans, refugee families and disaster affectees around the world. AKFP has been providing assistance to the needy people in Syria, Myanmar (Rohingya Muslims), Sri Lanka, Nepal and Indonesia with the help of on-ground partner relief organizations in respective countries.

A management committee monitors and evaluates the projects on the basis of mutual partnership strategies and encompasses criteria such as strategic fit, project's cycle, capacity of the organization and donors' requirements. At different points in a project life-cycle, proper monitoring and evaluation is carried out by the regional and district officials which enables the most effective demonstration of the impact and quality of work.

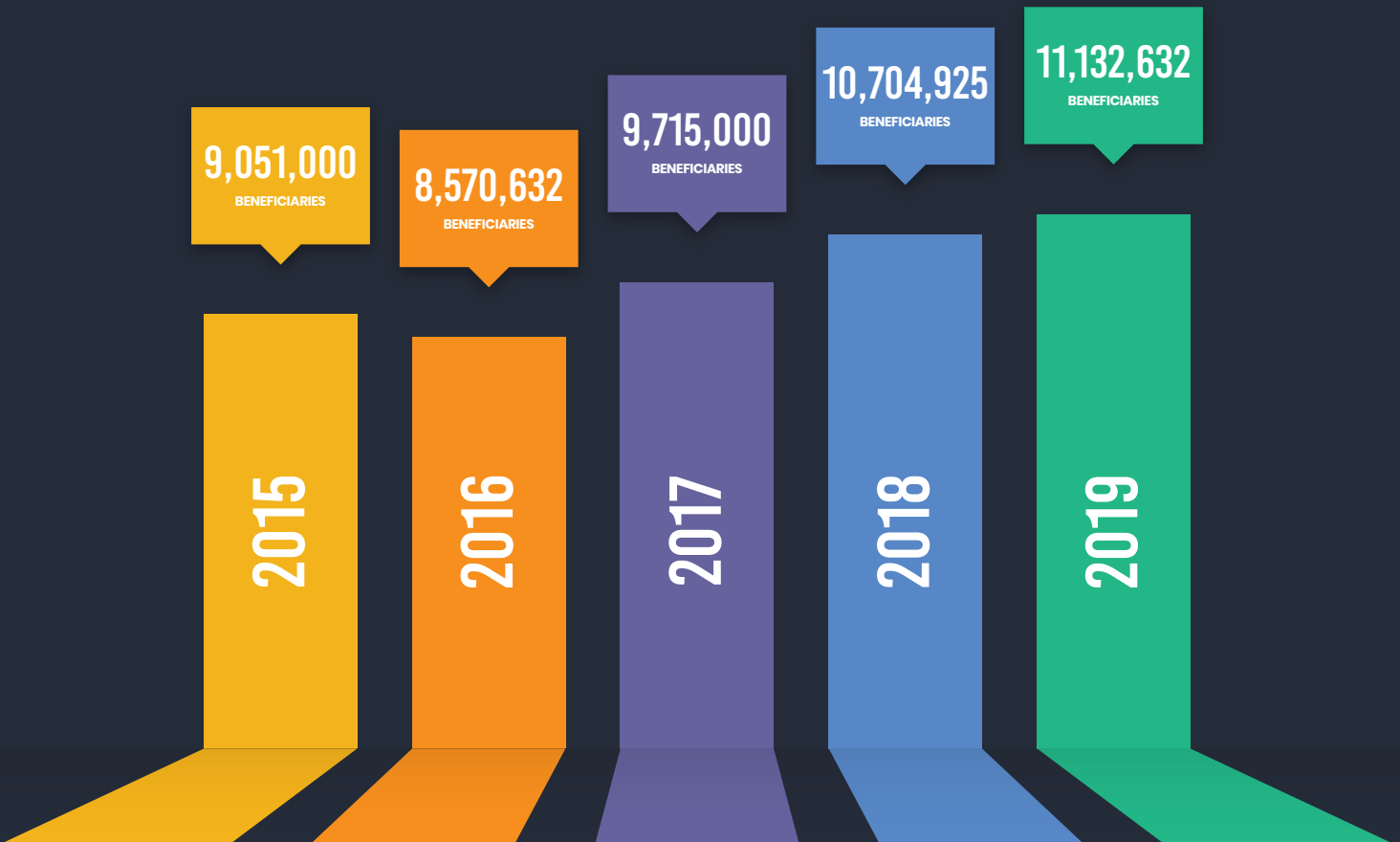


IMPACT 2019

Being among the leading non-profit and independent organizations in Pakistan, Alkhidmat Foundation is tirelessly providing multidimensional services in Disaster Management, Health, Education, Orphan Care, Clean Water, Mawakhat Program (Interest-free loans) and other Community Services. AKFP has implemented its motto “service to humanity with integrity” with true spirit over the decades. Today the number of beneficiaries from our seven service areas stands in millions across Pakistan and abroad.

In 2019, Health Services Program provided best healthcare facilities to over 7.2 Million beneficiaries while Disaster Management Program catered to the needs of 212,977 people. Similarly, Orphan Care Program served 12,225 orphans, Clean Water Program 2,240,900 people per day, Education Program reached out to 20,349 students, Mawakhat Program 1,182 beneficiaries, and Community Services Program cared for 1,033,425 individuals.

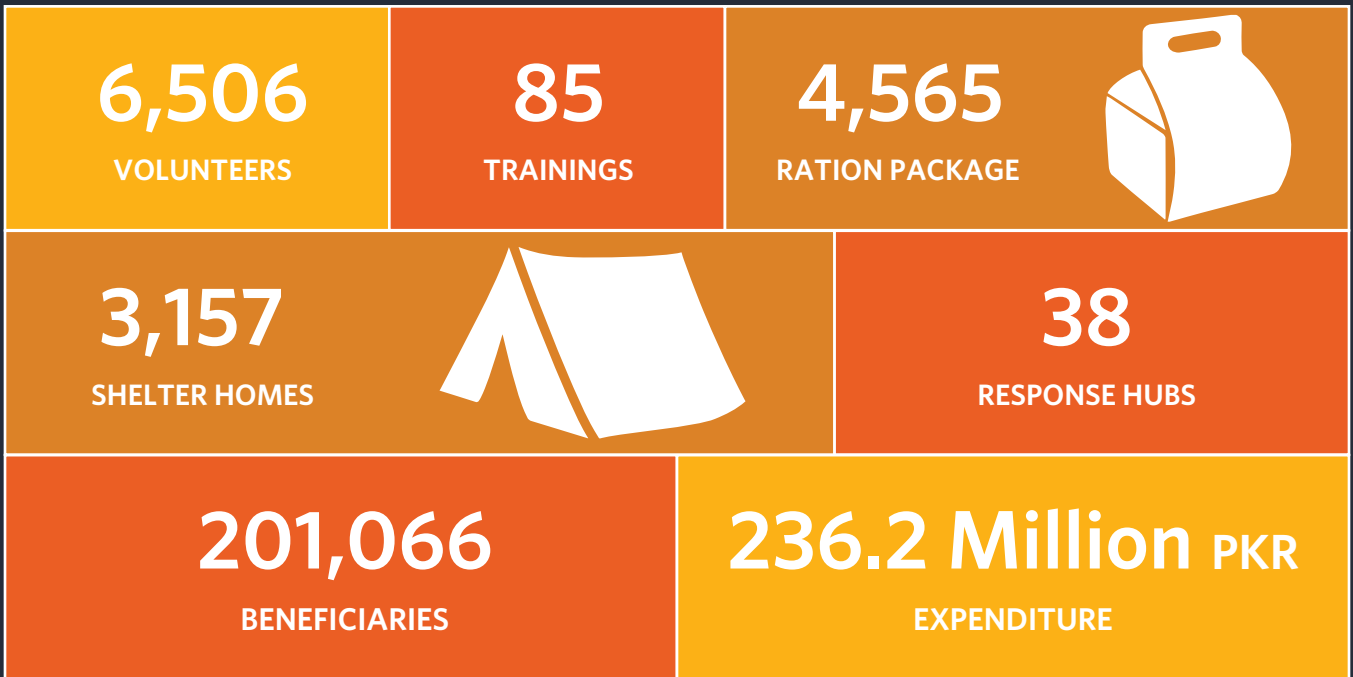


REACHING TO THE NEEDY

Disasters claim hundreds of lives every year. Scores of individuals die due to mismanagement in rescue operations and ill-trained early responders, while most of the survivors suffer from after incident trauma. Devastated communities also suffer due to unavailability of food and other things of daily use.

Alkhidmat Disaster Management program provided help during times of need including aid for the earthquake affected people of Mirpur Azad Kashmir in 2019. We also helped in the reconstruction of the infrastructure of the area by rebuilding the Masajid and roads. Reconstruction of devastated houses was also an integral part of our response in Mirpur.





Being among the developing countries, Pakistan has been prone to disasters for many decades. Unfortunately, Pakistan has faced several natural and man-made disasters in last 3 decades including huge floods, earthquakes and many other mishaps.

Alkhidmat Disaster Management program is a self-sufficient emergency response mechanism established after continuous efforts by the organization, its team of workers and volunteers across the country. This experienced and technologically equipped department has all capabilities ranging from the very first response to a calamity to the complete rehabilitation of victims and infrastructure both inside the country & abroad.



Rescue & Relief operation for Earthquake hit Mirpur

Our Response to Earthquake was phenomenal. Soon after the rescue operation at Mirpur Alkhidmat Foundation started relief activities for the earthquake affected families. Women, children and elderly were helpless to spend their days and nights under the open sky but Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan ensured the provision of tents, blankets and dried ration on the same day when the cruel earthquake jolted the whole district. Your contribution helped several needy families during this tough time.



Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan distributed Relief Packages on LOC



During the tense Indo-Pak situation Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan distributed Relief Packages containing ration and warm clothing among the people living near Line of Control (LOC). We never let our people in desperation and always remain the first to reach to the needy at any corner of the county. Disaster Management Program of Alkhidmat Foundation remains proactive to cope up with any emergency situation in the country and our volunteers are always committed to respond to any manmade or natural disaster.

Training of volunteers and staff under skills development program

Training our volunteers and staff has always been our priority to remain proactive to respond to any emergency situation across the country. Disaster Management Program of Alkhidmat Foundation trained 200 volunteers from Lower Punjab to respond to any natural or manmade disaster and emergency situations. Volunteers also gained experience to handle any major road accidents etc. The training was conducted by the team of professional from Rescue 1122.



Reaching out to save lives of flood affected people from Chitral

Alkhidmat Foundation reached to the fast flood affected areas in Golan Valley Chitral as the first responder to the emergency. After rescuing several injured and critical patients, our teams of volunteers distributed hundreds of food packages among the affected people. Our volunteers tracked the difficult rocks to reach the affected people to perform relief activities. Cooked food was also delivered at the valley to cater to the immediate need of the people.



Relief activity for the fire outbreak affected families in Astor



Losing your shelter is one of the most painful nightmare of a living being. An abrupt fire outbreak burnt 25 houses in District Astor – Gilgit Baltistan. Volunteers of Alkhidmat Disaster Management program were the first to reach out the affected families for rescue. Affected families were provided with Tents, Blankets, Warm Clothing and dried ration to survive and fight with the emergency situation.

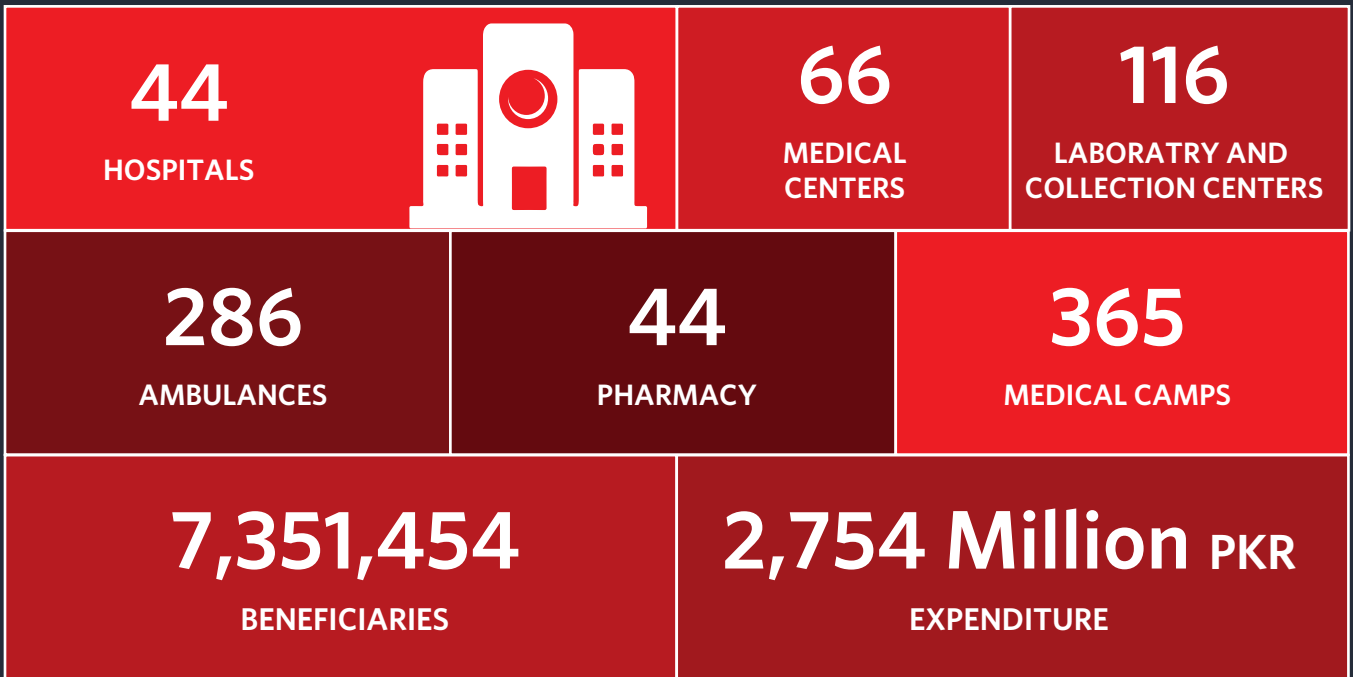


WE ARE HERE TO CARE

Health is a major concern of every civilization because healthy people create a healthier society.

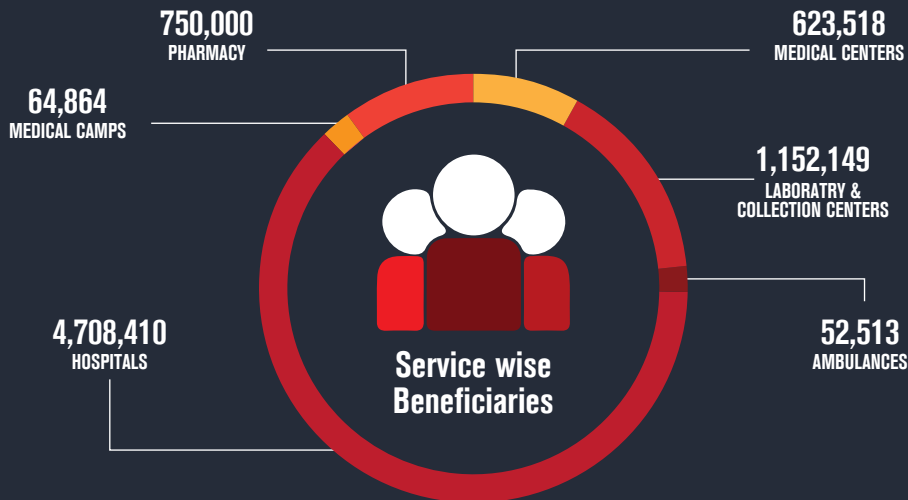
Alkhidmat Health Foundation is committed to serve the nation in a professional way by providing them the best health facilities. Our diagnostic labs are also offering the best diagnostic services on extremely subsidized rates and free for the poor and needy people across the country.

Equipped with the latest apparatus and technology we offer the best services to those who can't afford to get themselves tested from costly private diagnostic labs. We offer a vast range of clinical tests in all the labs where our professional and skilled staff performs tests to provide authentic results to help physicians diagnose and prescribe better treatment for the patients.



World Health Organization (WHO) has ranked Pakistan among 57 countries with critical health workforce deficiency while the country is placed at 154th position in terms of quality of healthcare facilities. Unfortunately Pakistan stands high in the list of top 10 countries with extreme infant mortality.

Being conscious of the situation, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan has established countrywide network to provide best healthcare facilities to public, irrespective of their socio-economic status. Under its umbrella currently several Hospitals, Medical Camps, Ambulance Service, Laboratory and Collection Centers and Pharmacies are functioning effectively across the country including landmark projects in the remotest and most under-developed areas such as Tharparkar (Sindh).



Inauguration of Mashal Medical Complex in Mardan

Alkhidmat Health Foundation always strives hard to reach new horizons and aim to the maximum extent. This year another landmark project of Alkhidmat has been completed. Mashal Medical Complex Mardan in collaboration with ICNA Relief Canada. This 50 bed medical facility is stretched on 27 Kanal land to offer Outdoor, Emergency, General and Private Wards, Laboratory, Ambulance, Mother & Child Healthcare and other medical facilities on extremely subsidized rates to the general public. Poor and needy may avail all these facilities for free.



Board Meeting of Alkhidmat Health Foundation at Alkhidmat Complex Lahore



Planning and review have always been the core component of our management style. Alkhidmat Health Foundation conducted its board meeting at Alkhidmat Complex Lahore. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Hafeez Ur Rehman, Vice Chairman of Alkhidmat Health Foundation. Regional Directors from all over Pakistan participated in the meeting to present their annual report. Audit reports of all regions and their mega projects were also critically reviewed.

Inauguration of newly constructed Diagnostic Lab in Chitral

Alkhidmat Health Foundation strongly believes in early detection of a disease to cure patients from fatal mishaps. The Foundation inaugurated Alkhdmat Diagnostic Lab at Chinar Market Chitral in the newly constructed building. Lab will provide the services of all clinical tests & radiological services on subsidized rates with the help of its qualified and trained staff while using the latest diagnostic equipment.

Knowing the importance of technology, Alkhidmat Health Foundation (AHF) sent a delegation under the supervision of Dr. Hafeez Ur Rehman, Vice Chairman AHF with other renowned specialist of the concern field to the "International Conference on Laboratory Medicine". 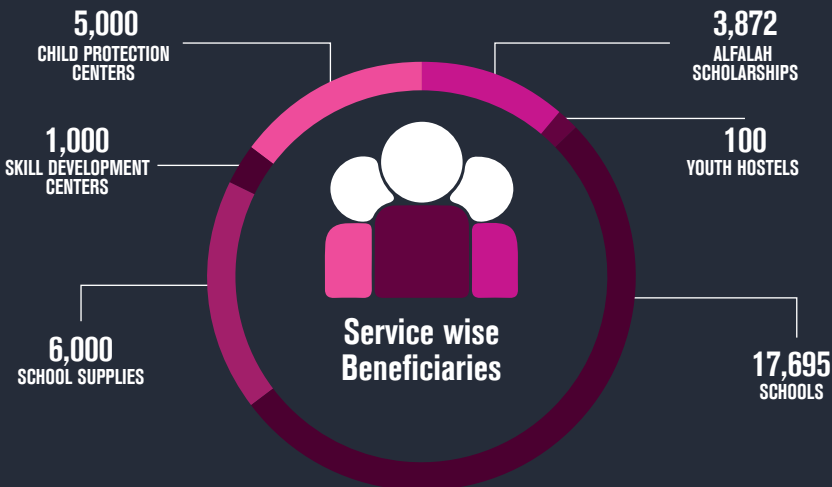
We aim to bring our country closer to its goal of 100 percent literacy rate and we are contributing to a national cause.



Low literacy rate of Pakistan has been a big issue for the country. Unfortunately, the ruling elites of the country have been ignoring this crucial issue since ages.

In order to cope up with the situation, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan is running educational institutions and related facilities across Pakistan with an aim to ensure education for every Pakistani. Both girls and boys are equally benefitted from our educational projects.

In collaboration with Child Protection and Rehabilitation Trust (CPRT), Child Protection Centers are established to rehabilitate street children and prepare them to join formal educational institutions. Alkhidmat Alfalah Scholarship Scheme is providing scholarships to talented needy students on regular basis.



Opening of another Chonra School in Tharparkar, Sindh

Education is the key to success. Alkhidmat Education Department started another Chonra school in Tharparkar with the kind support of National Bank of Pakistan. This school is located in village Jhol Shareef where 28 local children have been enrolled in the beginning. Children will be given quality education for free.

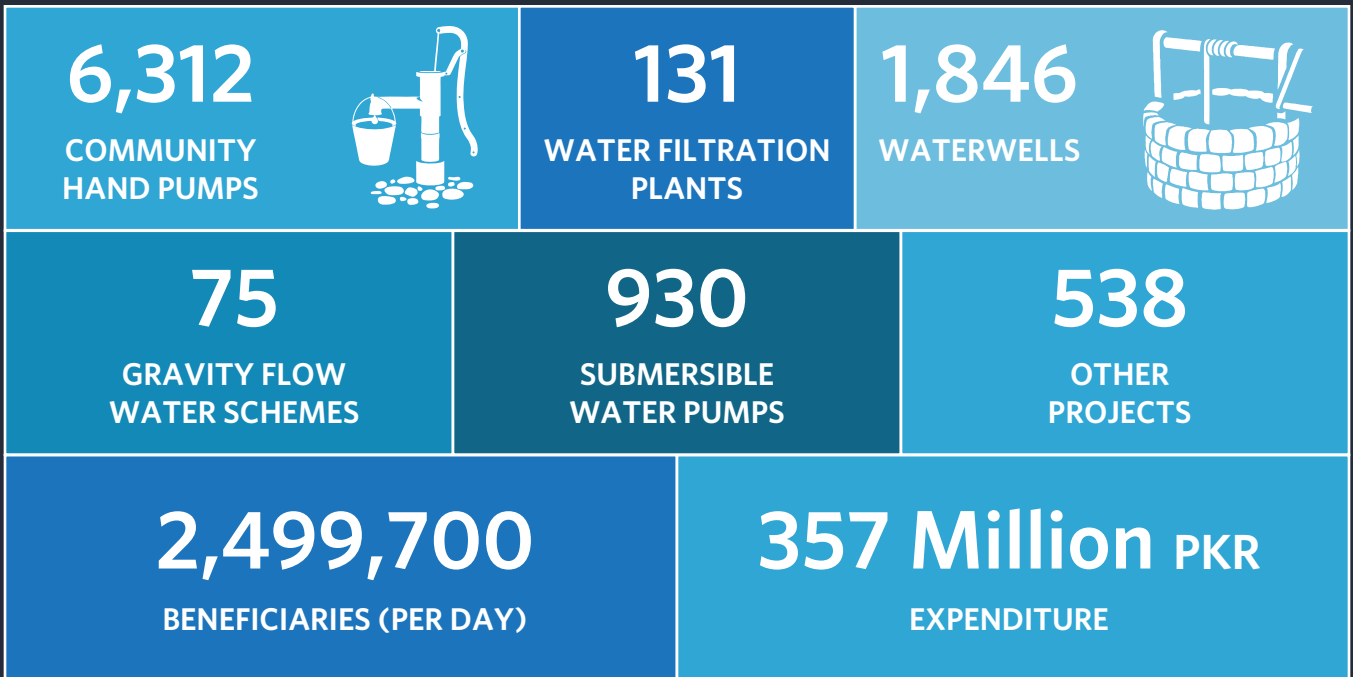
CLEAN WATER



WATER IS LIFE

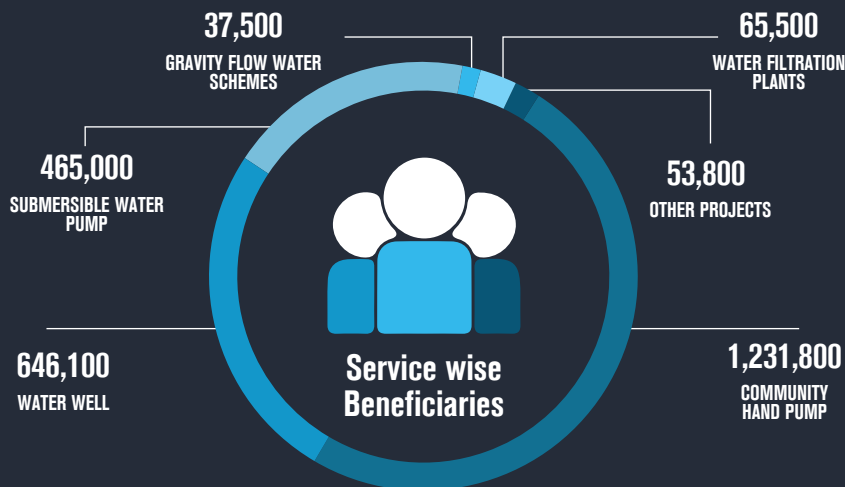
Most of the open-air water reservoirs have been identified polluted in Pakistan while contaminated water is the major cause of most of the diseases and epidemic burstouts in Pakistan during different seasons of the year. People are using contaminated water as there is no clean water available. Alkhidmat Clean Water program ensures the provision of clean drinking water to the locals at a desirable distance. We are committed to our thinking of “Clean Water... Safe Life”.

With its different approaches of establishing water projects like water wells, community hand pumps, solar water pumps and filtration plants, Alkhidmat is committed to provide clean drinking water to the people of Pakistan to help them save their health and life because “Water is Life”.



The grave condition of water scarcity is not new in Pakistan and the recent reports released by drinking water inspection authorities suggest that most of the people are drinking unhealthy water across the country. Global organizations have also placed Pakistan among countries where availability of clean drinking water is a serious issue.

Under Clean Water program, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan has completed hundreds of water projects that provide clean drinking water to needy communities across the country. This program ensures supply of clean drinking water in water-scarce areas as well as in big cities by installation of water pumps, handpumps and water filtration plants. In the mountainous areas, gravity flow schemes are implemented to ensure the supply of water to the households.



Clean Water. . . Safe Life

Alkhidmat Clean Water program celebrated world clean water day with the theme of “Clean Water.....Safe Life”. Awareness walks and seminars were arranged on the day to propagate the issue of clean water. Television Channels covered the event to communicate the issue of clean water to the masses; polluted water is the basic reason behind increased cases of Diarrhea and other water borne disease in Pakistan. We are striving to sensitize people about their responsibility to save water.



Installation of Two Water Filtration Plants in District Bahawalnagar

South Punjab is among the most water deficient areas in Punjab. Alkhidmat Clean Water program installed two new water filtration plants in Bahawalnagar District to facilitate more than 400 local people. These plants will provide clean drinkable water to the locals for free in order to ensure that clean water is provided to every household and people enjoy a healthier and happier life.



Inauguration of RO Filtration Plant in Karachi

Karachi is suffering from deficiency of clean drinkable water for many decades. In order to provide drinkable water to the residents of Aurangi Town Karachi, Alkhidmat Clean Water program inaugurated an RO Filtration Plant. The plant will provide clean drinkable water to the residents of Aurangi Town where more than 500 families will directly benefit from the project. This plant is mutually funded by Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan and TIKA - Turkey.



Completion of Another Clean Water Project in Balochistan

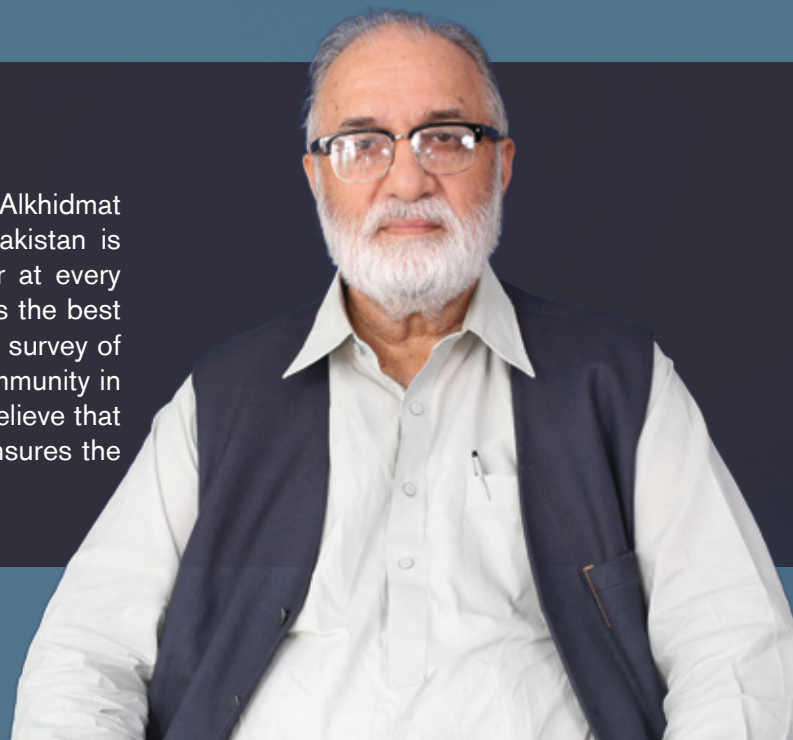

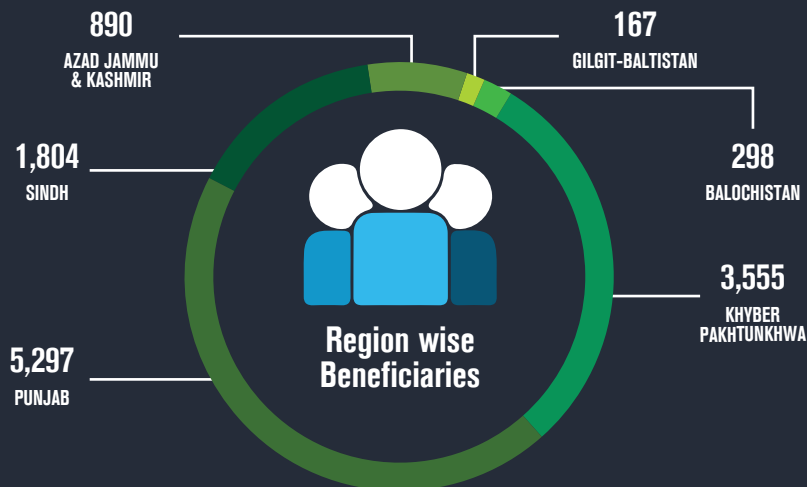
We are committed to provide the best facilities to these children as we know that every child has right to live a better life. We are providing them equal opportunities to grow and serve the nation as a contributing part of the society.



Orphans are considered as the most neglected segment of society worldwide, particularly in the developing countries which host most of the helpless orphan children (Pakistan has over 4.2 million orphan children). Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan has established Orphan Care Program to provide necessary support to these vulnerable children.

Orphan Family Support Program (OFSP)

Under this sponsorship program, the orphan boys and girls are provided financial assistance while they live at their own homes along with their family members. This program has established clusters all across the country. Every cluster is managed by a Family Support Organizer who stays in touch with the families of these orphan children throughout the year. 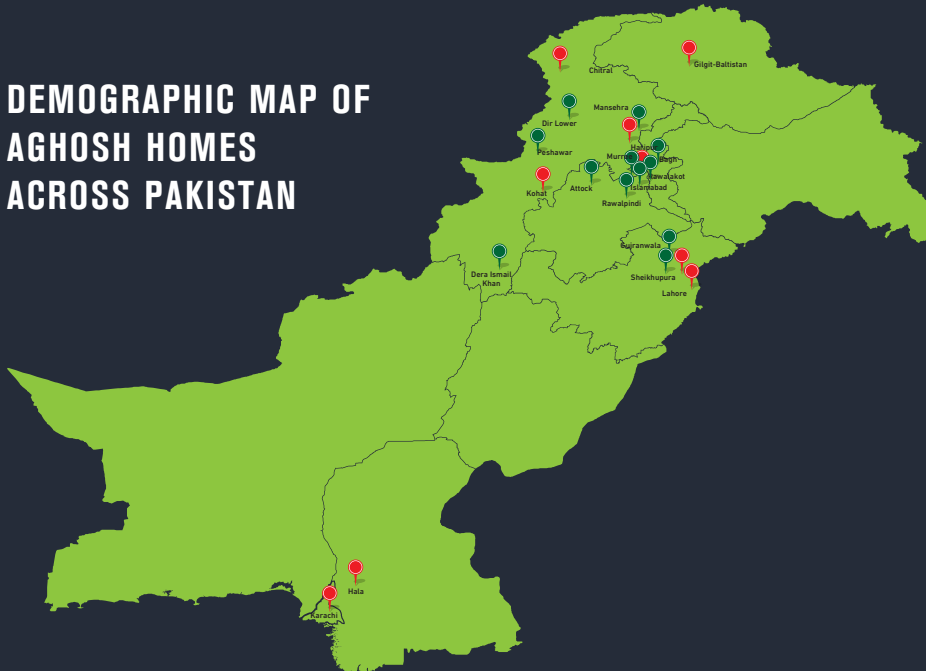

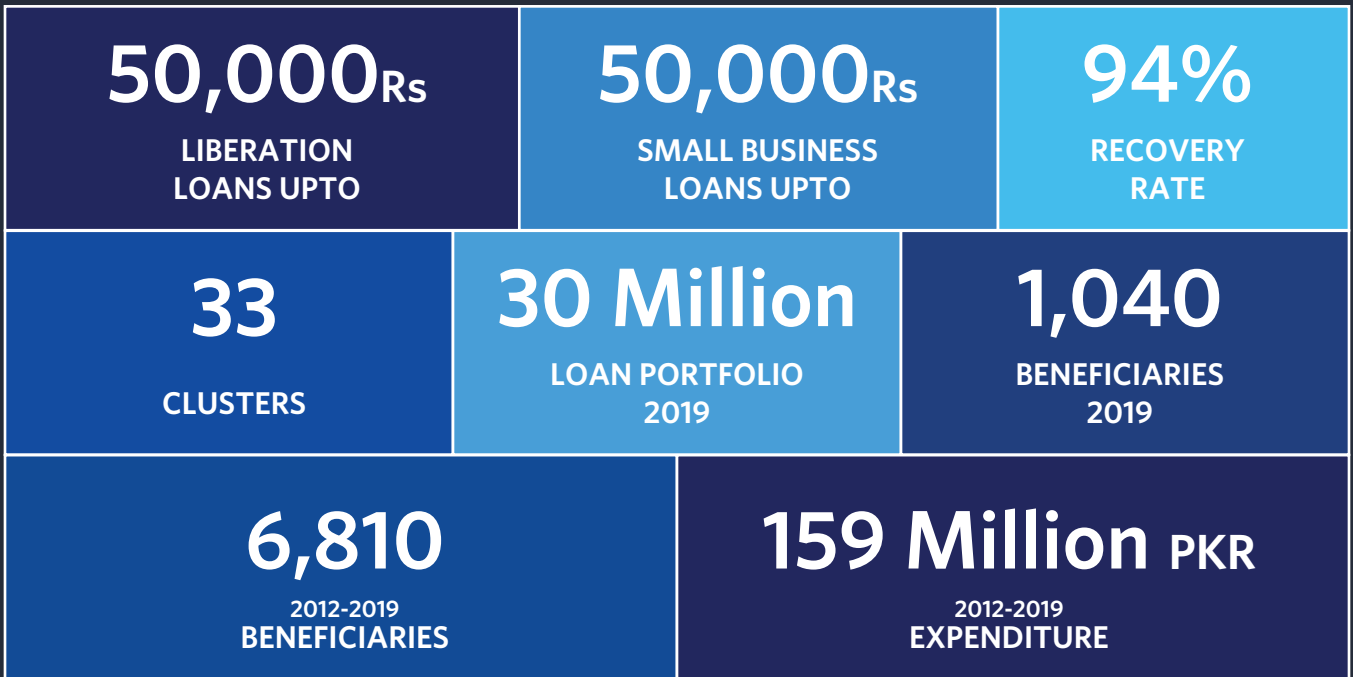


TOWARDS SELF RELIANCE

Mawakaht Program of Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan is unique in a sense that it offers special loans for the brave mothers who come forward to work and earn a respectful livelihood for their family.

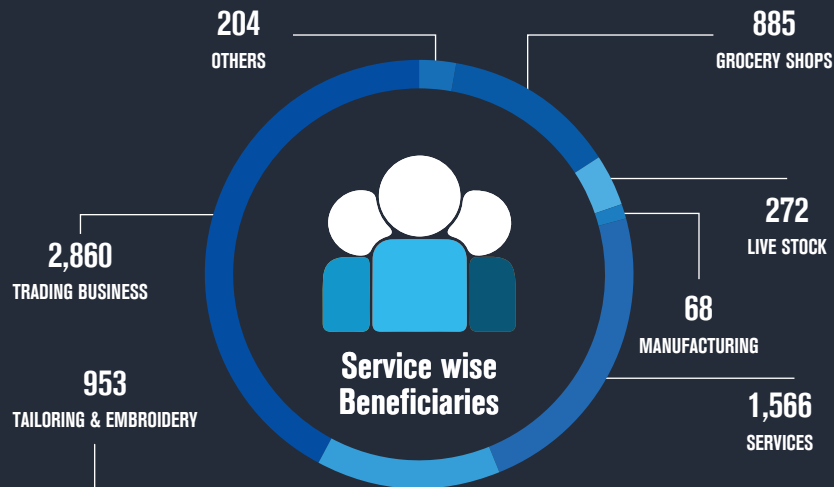
Mothers in some of the remotest areas of Pakistan like District Thar, get interest-free loans so that they can start their own business of making traditional dresses to sell. We believe that this will bring a positive change and a social uplift in our society as it helps increasing the confidence of deprived people.

As soon as they start earning a respectful living they become a contributing part of the society. The loan is then returned to Alkhidmat Foundation in monthly installments without any interest.



The high rate of unemployment is a major source of growing depression in the poverty-ridden society of Pakistan. In such a situation, a number of microfinance schemes are being run across the country. However, unlike most of such schemes, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan's Mawakhat Program is based on the Islamic principle of Qarz-e-Hasna.

Under this program, the needy people are provided with interest-free loans to support their small businesses as well as to help them repay their debts. The people interested in Mawakhat Program approach local AKFP offices through an application along with required documents, and upon due consideration they receive the loan amount. The beneficiaries return the net loan amount to Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan within an agreed time period in the form of easy installments. Any sort of additional amount is not charged.



Provision of Interest Free Loan in Gilgit Baltistan

Respectful earning is a dream of every independent human. Running the expense of ones household is the biggest challenge for every breadwinner in the lower income class of Pakistan. Since Gilgit Baltistan is among the low socioeconomic areas of the country, Alkhidmat Mawakhat program identified and disbursed interest-free loans among 60 individuals. This loan will help them establish their own business and earn a respectful living for their family. The loan will be returned in monthly installments without any interest.



Interest Free Loan Cheque Distribution in Multan



Another 54 hardworking and committed individuals got interest-free loan to start their own business in Multan. Alkhidmat Mawakhat program arranged the ceremony for cheque disbursement at Multan. With a total amount of Rs. 1,218,000 Mawakhat program gave the opportunity to 54 families to live a happy and respectful life. This disbursement will surely bring a happy and positive change in the daily life of these poor and needy families.

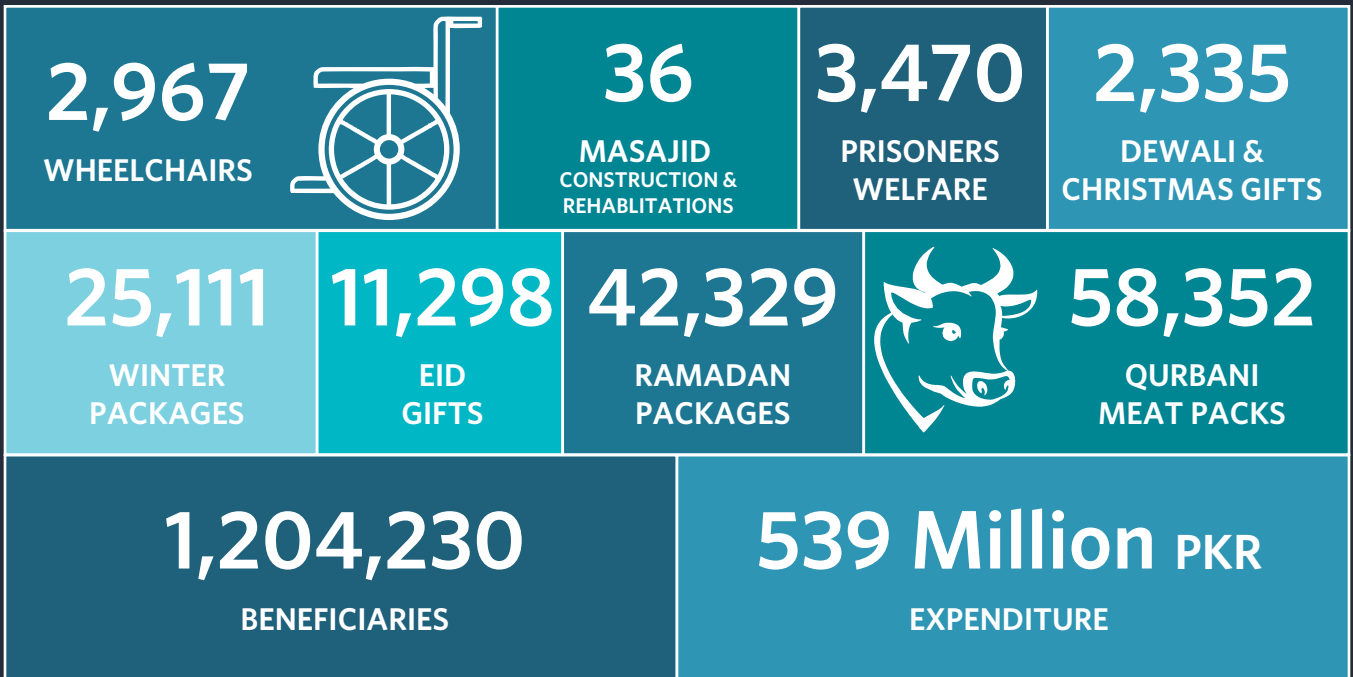


SHARING SMILES

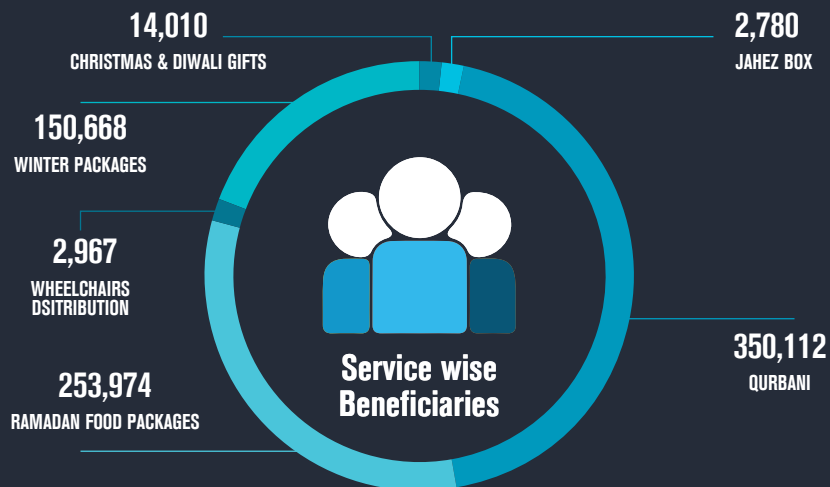

Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Society's to cease to continue as a going concern.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
