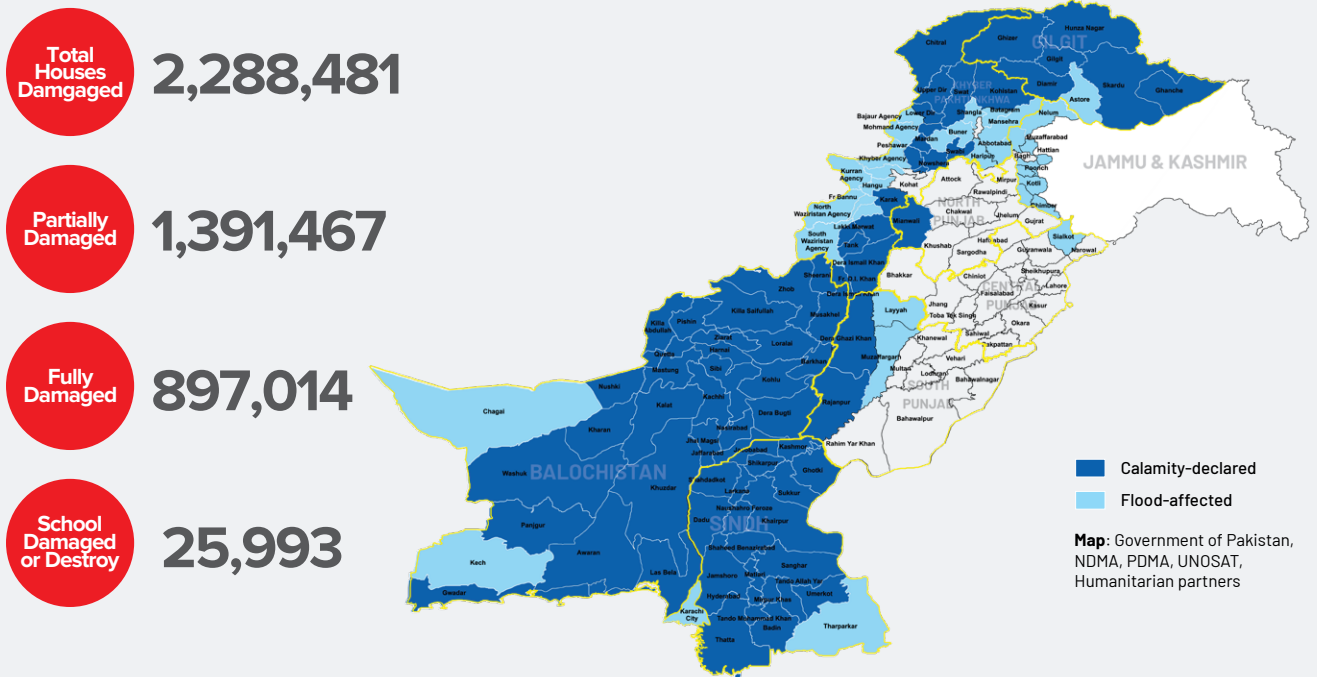

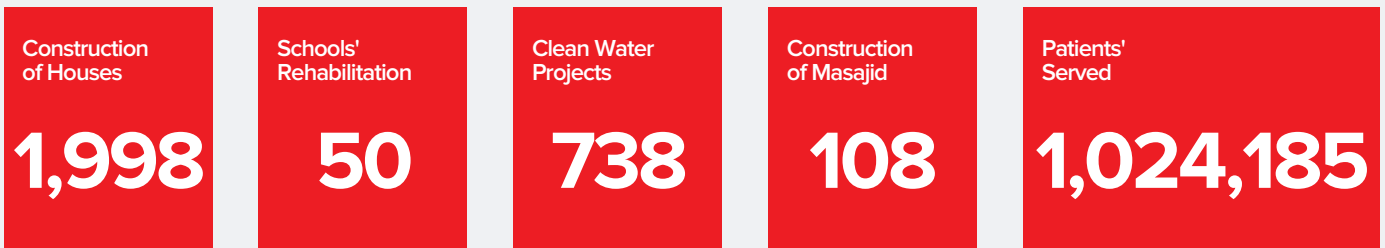
Pakistan: 2022 Monsoon Floods

According to the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), this year's monsoon rains across the country have broken a 30-year record. Massive devastation has been witnessed across Pakistan from Gilgit Baltistan in the north of the country to Karachi in the south. Consequently, rains have destroyed critical basic infrastructure including houses, crops, roads, bridges, schools, hospitals and public health facilities. As per NDMA's October 31 report, the floods have affected more than 33 million people in 85 districts while many districts of Sindh and Balochistan are still under water, causing rapid outbreak of epidemics across provinces. In addition, over 650,000 expectant women are in urgent need of medical assistance.



Rehabilitation of Flood Affectees

At present, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan is simultaneously doing relief and rehabilitation work in flood-hit areas across the country. Rehabilitation program worth PKR 5 billion has been started in Sindh, Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and South Punjab. Under the Alkhidmat rehabilitation program, relief activities mentioned below will be carried out in flood-hit areas across Pakistan.



Reconstruction & Repair of Houses

To help rebuild the 2.2 million devastated abodes nationwide, Alkhidmat is carrying out Houses Reconstruction & Repair under Alkhidmat Tameer-e-Watan Program for the rehabilitative construction of homes of the flood victims rendered homeless by the massive inundation. Alkhidmat is providing assistance for flood-damaged house reconstruction. Some common types of assistance include full financial aid for rebuilding and the provision of building materials for repairs.

Reconstruction & Repair of Schools

Alkhidmat is deeply concerned about the worrisome disruption of educational activities after floods had destroyed thousands of schools across the country. As an immediate response, Alkhidmat set up temporary learning centers at tent villages to help resume academic activities in an emergency. And now Alkhidmat Schools Reconstruction & Repair Projects across the country includes the process of repairing, renovating and updating existing school buildings to improve the physical condition and functionality of the facility.



Clean Water Projects

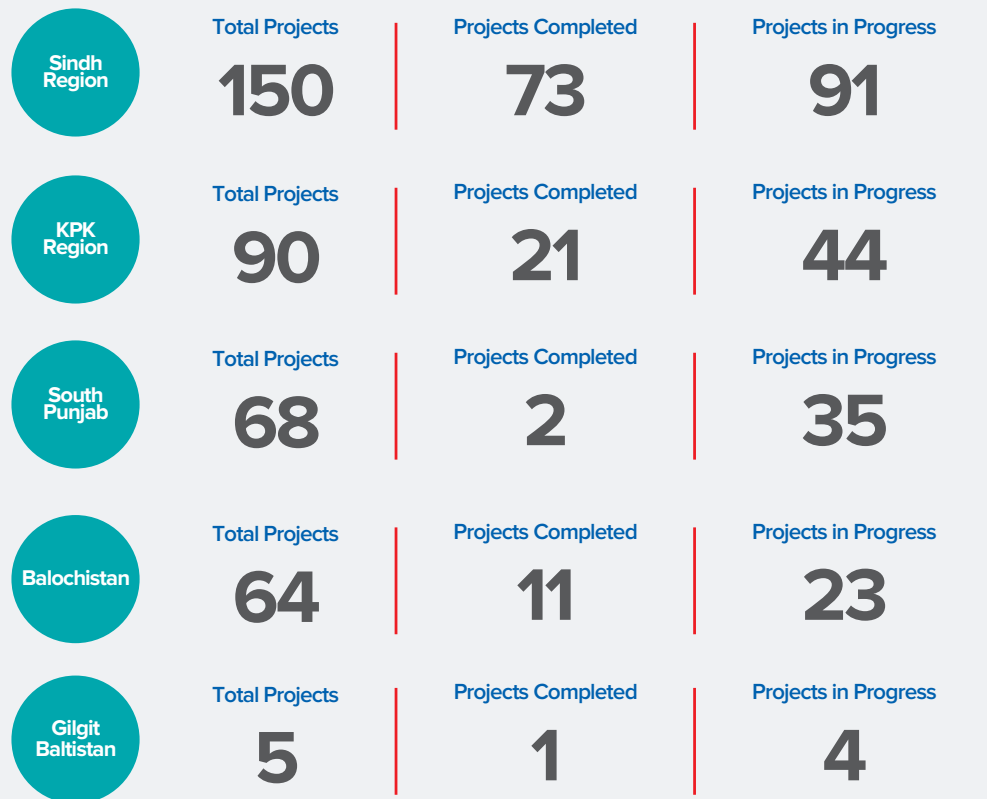
Thousands of water reservoirs, freshwater streams and clean water facilities in hardest hit flood areas of Pakistan have suffered major damage, leaving already vulnerable communities exposed to increased risk of disease, especially women and children. Alkhidmat is carrying out various Clean Water Projects in order to ensure clean drinking water supply to the populations in affected areas across Pakistan.

Reconstruction & Repair of Masajid

Sadly, thousands of Masajid, including many historic ones, were severely damaged by floods in areas across Pakistan. As a result, millions of devotees were deprived of congregational prayers while young children and students faced disruption of Quran classes. As a response, Alkhidmat has launched the Masajid Reconstruction & Repair Projects and has been providing financial assistance for the reconstruction of flood-damaged Masajid in flood affected areas across Pakistan.



Medical Relief

In a situation where 650,00 pregnant women were at high risk of complications in flood-affected areas and urgent healthcare and delivery assistance was necessitated, Alkhidmat launched the Safe Mother - Safe Family project. This project aims to not only ensure safe delivery and childbirth, but also provide quality prenatal and postnatal care with pre-packaged sterile Delivery Kits to guarantee utmost health and hygiene for both mother and newborn.
